2. Composition:

Heelbalm contains:

INCI = Paraffinum Liquidum

INCI = Mentha Piperita Oil

3. Hazards Identification

Not regarded as a health or environmental hazard under current legislation.

No hazard anticipated provided product is used for purpose intended.

4. First Aid Measures

In all cases of doubt or when symptoms persist, always seek medical advice.

Ingestion: Only when conscious, rinse mouth with plenty of water and give plenty of water to drink or milk to drink (approx 500ml). **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** In the case of spontaneous vomiting, be sure that vomit can freely drain because of the danger of suffocation. Seek medical attention.

Skin: Wash affected area with plenty of soap and water.

Eyes: Rinse immediately with copious amounts of water. If irritation or discomfort persists, seek medical attention.

5. Fire Fighting Measures

Heelbalm is not flammable but will burn in a fire situation.
Use foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide fire extinguishers.

6. Accidental Release Measures

Personal precaution if spilt - Spillage may constitute a slipping hazard.

Precautions to protect the environment - Prevent contamination of soil, drains and surface water.

Spill clean up methods - Take-up spillage with an absorbent, inert material and place in a suitable and closable labelled container for recovery or disposal. Wash the area clean with water and detergent, observing environmental requirements. Ensure adequate ventilation in areas after accidental spillage.

7. Handling and Storage

Product available in 50g and 100g tubes packed in cardboard cartons

Keep container tightly closed. Store in a cool, dry place in the original container

8. Exposure Controls and Personal Protection

Use normal conditions of use, no exposure controls or personal protection equipment are required.

9. Physical and Chemical Properties

Form: Semi solid ointment

Colour: White

Solubility: insoluble in water

10. Stability and Reactivity

Stable under normal conditions of use and storage instructions for 24 months
Avoid excessive heat
